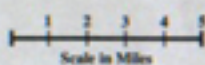

## Safety & Respecting Private Property

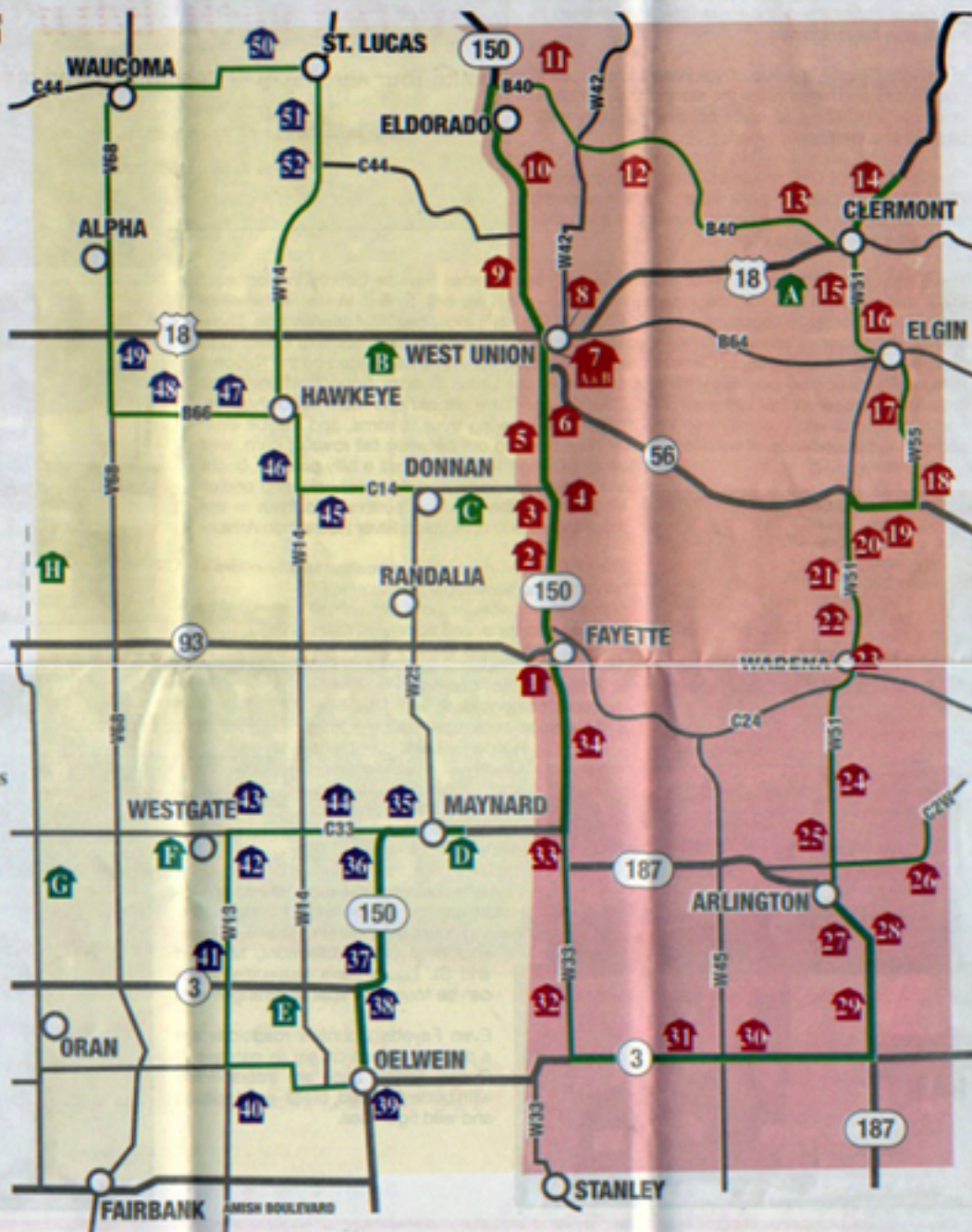
